

High Plains Motocross Association Code of Conduct

The High Plains Motocross Association (H.P.M.A.) is a non-profit organization dedicated to promoting the sport of motocross racing. This Code of Conduct (Code) has been developed to ensure that the H.P.M.A. is a safe, friendly, and respectful place for all members, volunteers, and guests of the H.P.M.A. to gather and compete. The H.P.M.A. expects all members to act responsibly and ethically, as well as following the standards set forth below.

As a member of the H.P.M.A., whether for the following year or for just a single day, you have a responsibility adhere to the following standards of conduct while acting on behalf of, associating with, volunteering for, competing with, or while identifiable as a member of the H.P.M.A.:

- The H.P.M.A. does not tolerate any form of harassing behavior. Any physical, verbal, or sexual harassment will not be tolerated.
- Obscenities, aggressive, inappropriate, or offensive behavior shall not be tolerated.
- The H.P.M.A. is committed to providing a welcoming and inclusive environment for everyone. Discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, creed, gender, gender expression, age, national origin, ancestry, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, or military status shall not be tolerated.
- Members will treat all race officials, volunteers, scorers, and referees with courtesy and respect.
- Members will refrain from acting in any manner which would damage or jeopardize the reputation or name of the H.P.M.A.
- Members are responsible for the actions and behaviors of their guests while attending any H.P.M.A. meeting or event.
- Members, or parents of members, are responsible for discussing this Code with their children, or underage members.

As a member of the H.P.M.A., I have had an opportunity to read the High Plains Motocross Association Code of Conduct and agree to abide by its terms. By way of my signature hereto, I understand that the Code has been drafted to protect the integrity and atmosphere of the H.P.M.A. for all members, volunteers, and guests. I also acknowledge that refusal to sign this Code may prevent me from maintaining membership or racing with the H.P.M.A.
